| CM Johnson | 14. Municipal Agreement for the Rea Road Widening Project from I-485 Outer Loop to Williams Pond Lane Is there additional funding for improvements to other state roads? Ie Mallard Creek? | All of the managed lanes bonus allocation (BA) funds have been allocated and projects are underway. The full list of BA projects includes: Rea Rd (Charlotte), WT Harris Street lighting (Charlotte), McKee Road/Weddington Road intersection (Charlotte and Matthews), Greylock Ridge Rd Extension (Matthews). Through State Transportation Improvement Funds (STIP), the NCDOT has recently completed widening of 2.5 miles of Mallard Creek Road, from Sugar Creek Road to WT Harris Blvd. The current STIP includes two Mallard Creek Road widening projects: Mallard Creek Church Road to I-485 (construction in 2025), and I-485 to Concord Mills Boulevard (construction in 2028). These projects will complete the widening of Mallard Creek Road from 2 lanes to 4 lanes within the Charlotte city limits. |
