**EXHIBIT A**  
**REVISIONS TO CHAPTER 23, SECTION 23-41**  
**and CHAPTER 23, SECTION 23-126 OF THE CITY CODE**

**Sec. 23-41. - Systems operations.** The sewage treatment and disposal facilities and sewage collection system shall be operated as, and considered to be, a single, integrated system. Any revenue collected by Charlotte Water shall be sufficient to meet: (i) the annual principal and interest payable and any associated fees on the debt incurred for construction of the sewer system and associated infrastructure; and (ii) the amount necessary for repairs, maintenance and operation of the system.

**Sec. 23-126. - Water system operation.** The water treatment facilities and water distribution system shall be operated as, and considered to be, a single, integrated system. Any revenue collected by Charlotte Water shall be sufficient to meet: (i) the annual principal and interest payable and any associated fees on the debt incurred for construction for the water system and associated infrastructure; and (ii) the amount necessary for repairs, for fire protection, maintenance and operation of the system.
