State Law on Vacancies:

- ► The vacancy shall be filled by appointment of the City Council
- ▶ In cities whose elections are conducted on a partisan basis, the person appointed shall be a member of the same political party as the person being replaced.

- ▶ Be a registered Republican
- ▶ Be a registered voter
- ▶ Be 21 years of age or older
- ► Be a resident of the district and qualified to vote in City Council District 6.
