MPTA Appointments – Work Group Process Recommendations

Council Discussion from 10/6/2025

- More opportunity to give input into which candidates are interviewed
- More input into questions that are asked
- Ability for Council Members to attend the interviews

MPA Appointments – Work Group Process Recommendations

- Oct 14
 - Council receives all applications and resumes (special delivery)
- Oct 20
 - Request nominations from Alliance, Foundation for the Carolinas and Mayor
 - 30-minute interviews
 - Council Members submit top two questions
 - Council members select top three applicants per category (nine categories)
 - *Use survey monkey for voting (as used previously)*
 - *Council input used to prioritize and identify applicants for interviews*

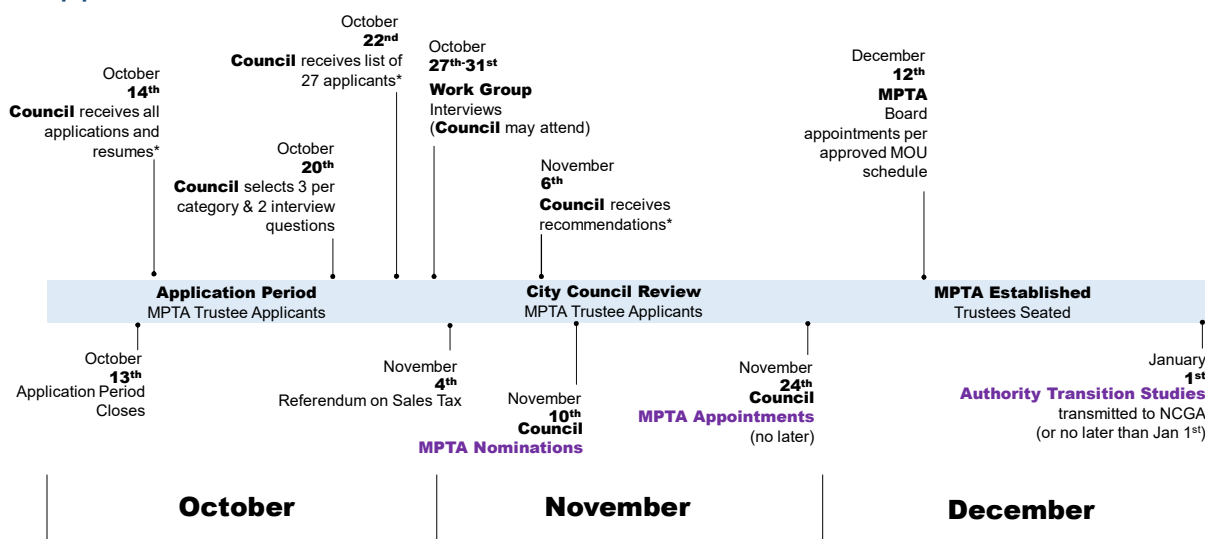
MPA Appointments – Work Group Process Recommendations

- Oct 22
 - Notify Council of 27 applicants moving forward to interviews
- Oct 27-31 Interviews
 - Up to 30-minute interviews
 - Up to 11 questions per applicant (up to 22 questions will be used throughout the interview process)
 - Work Group further prioritize based on interview process using evaluation criteria

MPA Appointments – Work Group Process Recommendations

- Nov 6
 - Recommendations from Work Group will be ranked first, second and third per category
 - Include criteria Work Group used to make recommendations from interviews
- Nov 10
 - Each Council Member will nominate one applicant per category
- Nov 24
 - Final vote from Council for all appointments
