WHEREAS, A Grant Agreement between the City of Charlotte and the US Department of Transportation (USDOT) will allow the City to be reimbursed for work associated with the development of a regional Comprehensive Safety Action Plan for the Charlotte Regional Transportation Planning Organization (CRTPO) planning area; and,

WHEREAS, the Grant Agreement provides for reimbursement up to \$3,150,000 of the total cost of the project; and,

WHEREAS, the Grant Agreement requires a 20% match of \$787,500 which will be fulfilled with in-kind contributions from CRTPO member jurisdictions, and a cash match subsidy from the NCDOT; and,

WHEREAS, the NCDOT will enter into an Interlocal Agreement with the City to contribute a local cash match subsidy of \$500,000 from North Carolina Highway Safety Improvement Program; and,

WHEREAS, the format and cost-sharing philosophy is consistent with past Municipal Agreements; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this Resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a Grant Agreement with the USDOT to reimburse the City up to \$3,150,000 for the development of a regional Comprehensive Safety Action Plan, and execute an Interlocal Agreement with the NCDOT to contribute \$500,000 in cash match subsidy, is hereby formally approved by the City Council of the City of Charlotte and the City Manager and Clerk of this Municipality.
