

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE TO CHANGE THE LENGTH OF TERMS OF THE MAYOR AND MEMBERS OF THE CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL FROM TWO YEARS TO FOUR YEARS

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte:

Section 1. Pursuant to G.S.160A-101 and 160A-102, the Charter of the City of Charlotte, as set forth in Chapter 2 of the 2000-26 Session Law of North Carolina, as amended, is hereby further amended to provide that the mayor and members of the Charlotte City Council shall hereafter be elected for four-year terms.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be effective only upon approval by a vote of the people. A special election for the purpose of submitting the ordinance to a vote shall be held as provided by resolution also adopted this day.
