


#### **Policy Question:**

- Potential policy and CIP recommendations






### **Strategic Investment Areas:** What are they?

• **Data-driven:** from conception to outcome (measuring success)

- Comprehensive but geographically focused & context-specific, one size does not fit all
  - Playbook of projects across all modes & partners
  - Scalable "Bundles" of investment, sum is greater than the parts
  - Positioned for execution & funding opportunistic: Local, State, Federal, Private


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Our Plan

- Increase capacity through operational and physical improvements, including important street network connections and added travel lanes in targeted areas
- Support the development of the Activity Center and planned light rail corridor into a multimodal place that helps meet mode shift goals and provides additional employment and recreational opportunities for surrounding communities
- Improve safe and comfortable access for pedestrians and bicyclists to and within the Activity Center in support 10-minute neighborhoods



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


Our Plan

- Provide multimodal access to transit along a major corridor connecting High Frequency/Priority Bus transit with the Blue Line
- Provide better multimodal access to Arrowood Transit Station and other Activity Centers (e.g., Nations Ford/Arrowood and Whitehall) to support 10minute neighborhoods
- Increase safe, multimodal access to jobs, greenspace, and educational facilities for transportation disadvantaged communities in the central and eastern portions of the SIA
- Increase capacity with operational improvements, transit, and added travel lanes in the western portions of the X.
- Provide safe crossings, pedestrian, bike, and transit facilities throughout the
