Steele Creek Presbyterian Church and Cemetery

A MOTION WAS PRESENTED AND SECONDED THAT THE HISTORIC LANDMARKS COMMISSION RECOMMEND TO CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL THAT THE DESIGNATION ORDINANCE FOR THE STEELE CREEK PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH AND CEMETERY, 7401 AND 7407 STEELE CREEK ROAD, CHARLOTTE, N.C., BE AMENDED TO DE-DESIGNATE THE ASSOCIATED 23 ACRES AS PRESENTED, WHILE MAINTAINING THE ORIGINAL LANDMARK DESIGNATION AS TO THE REMAINING APPROXIMATELY 14.245 ACRES, INCLUDING THE INTERIOR AND EXTERIOR OF THE CIRCA 1889 SANCTUARY BUILDING, THE CIRCA 1763 CEMETERY, AND ASSOCIATED HISTORIC STRUCTURES. THE COMMISSION UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED THE MOTION.
