What is a Social District?





Social Districts are areas where people can walk around with open, togo containers of alcoholic beverages. Beverages must be purchased from a permitted bar, restaurant, or other establishment, and consumed within the boundaries and hours of the social district.

- ► Charlotte City Council adopted an ordinance allowing the creation of social districts:
 - Established legal requirements within City Code
 - Authorized the creation of a Standards and Provisions document
 - ▶ Allows the City to consider community proposals for Social Districts
- ▶ CDOT published the Final *Standards and Provisions*
- Pre-Application/Application are being accepted

- ► Requested outside of the Central Business District



Application Requirements

Application Components:

- Boundary Map/Signage Plan
- Management and Maintenance Plan
- Documentation of Community Engagement

Community Engagement:

- Petition indicating support of at least 51% of property owners within the proposed district
- Community Meeting
 - · Can be held virtually
 - All residents notified within ½ mile of the district
- ► Letters of Support



Summary of Application



- ▶ Applicant: Plaza Midwood Merchants Association
- Operating hours: Monday-Sunday, 10AM-10PM
- Management and Maintenance Plan:
 - · District funded
 - · Establishes a committee for oversight
 - · Provides boundary and business signage
 - · Reusable stainless-steel cups
- Community Engagement:
 - Petition provide with greater than 51% support
 - Virtual meeting on June 1, 2023 with \sim 75 attendants
 - Letters of Support from Commonwealth-Morningside and Chantilly Neighborhood Associations
- This application has met minimum City and State requirements



Department Comments

- Office of Sustainability: No objections
- Attorney's Office, Planning, CDOT, and Solid Waste Services: No objections pending minor revisions to the Management and Maintenance Plan
 - Clarifications related to citing applicable N.C General Statutes and City Code
 - · Clarifications related to trash and recycling responsibilities
 - Removal of language related to the permitting of vendors or special events
- CMPD: No objections pending the opportunity to enhance public safety in the following areas
 - The addition of intentional signage for excluded or opted out locations providing participant clarity and reducing confusion
 - Continued conversations regarding the district boundary and potential impacts to surrounding residential and commercial properties
 - Clarifications related to providing a committee liaison to work with CMPD
