While the land use is inconsistent with the use designated in • the area plan, the petition overall supports the area plan's goal of accommodating higher intensity uses that support the various transportation systems throughout the corridor. • As written, TOD-CC may be applied to parcels within a 1/2mile walking distance of an existing rapid transit station. Use of conventional TOD zoning districts applies standards • and regulations to create the desired form and intensity of transit supportive development, and a conditional rezoning is not necessary. The approval of this petition will revise the adopted future land use as specified by the University City Area Plan - Blue Line Extension (2015), from Office/Retail to Transit Oriented Development for the site.
