A voluntary annexation area has to meet two main geographical requirements- 1) The land has to be within Charlotte's Sphere of Influence (as determined by our annexation agreements with surrounding municipalities) Of the 240,633 acres within Charlotte's Sphere of Influence, 41,296 acres are not in existing City Limits. 2) A majority of the proposed annexation has to be within three miles of existing City Limits. Nearly all areas (the majority of the 41,296 acres) that are within Charlotte's Sphere of Influence but not already in City Limits, are within the 3-mile threshold to existing City Limits that is required to annex.
