Therefore, we find this petition to be reasonable and in the public interest, based on the information from the staff analysis and the public hearing, and because: The proposed land use is consistent with the adopted multi-family land use for the site and meets the General Development Policies (GDPs) for allowing up to 17 DUA for this site. The proposed site plan proposes to extend Heywood • Avenue and implement 8' planting strip and 6' sidewalk on both sides of the street. The petition proposes to construct single family attached dwellings, a form of "missing middle housing", in close proximity to CATS bus stops, retail, and public schools.
