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Committee Charge

Housing, Safety, and Community

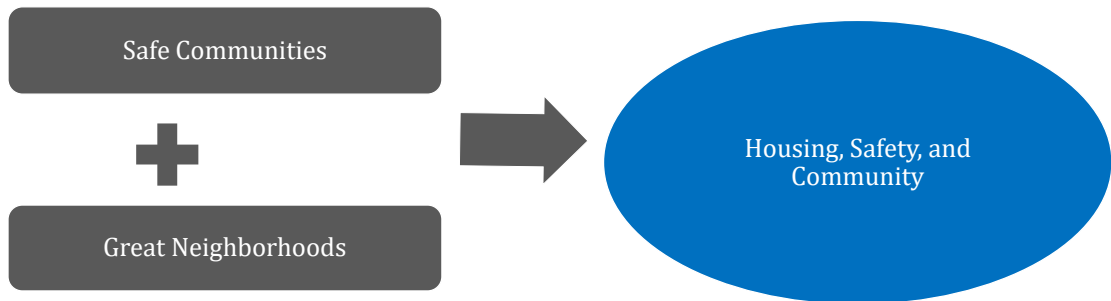
Reviews and recommends policies to provide for safe and affordable housing, engage the community, increase safety, and promote equity.

Committee Referrals

- ▶ **Anti-displacement:** The newly appointed Neighborhood Equity and STabilization (NEST) Commission will provide additional input
 - Recommend integration of existing and relevant City anti-displacement policies and programs and consider new policies and programs to protect vulnerable communities from displacement.
- ▶ **Supporting Affordable Housing Development– June 6, 2022 (referral)**
 - Review feedback from the development community as to how development fees may impact opportunities to leverage affordable housing options
 - Assess the current fee structure and components for Affordable Housing, including legal framework or constraint
 - Explore feasible options and proposed next steps for consideration by full Council
- ▶ **Sustaining Neighborhood Trees – June 6, 2022 (referral)**
 - Review current programs and policies related to tree canopy maintenance
 - Review past initiatives that provided for tree assessments on private properties
 - Survey best practices being used in other cities to provide support for maintenance of trees on private property
 - Determine if there are other feasible options to promote the health of heritage trees and their removal when any become a potential hazard.
 - Propose any new or revised plans or policies that the
 - Committee recommends on providing assistance to residents with tree maintenance.
 - Include proposed metrics for any recommendations to gauge success
