ZONING COMMITTEE DISCUSSION	Staff provided a summary of the petition, noting all outstanding issues were addressed and that it is consistent with the 2040 Policy Map. Planning staff confirmed that the appropriate zoning district must be in place prior to seeking tax credits. Commissioner Lansdell identified the site as located on a high injury network and noted the need for equitable outcomes with respect to equity. Commissioner Welton inquired about the		

ability to access a map or layer that identifies high injury location, and Vision Zero was mentioned. There was no further discussion of this petition.
