WHEREAS, A Supplemental Agreement to an existing Municipal Agreement between the City and the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will allow the City to be reimbursed for the installation of a new traffic signal at Independence Boulevard and Sharon Forest Drive associated with the Independence Boulevard widening project; and,

WHEREAS, the Supplemental Agreement provides for reimbursement not to exceed \$148,800 of the total cost of the project; and,

WHEREAS, the format and cost sharing philosophy is consistent with past Municipal Agreements: and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a Supplemental Agreement with the NCDOT for NCDOT to reimburse the City up to \$148,800 in addition to \$472,000 of the original Municipal Agreement for a total of \$620,800 for the traffic signal work associated with the Independence Boulevard widening project, is hereby formally approved by the City Council of the City of Charlotte and the City Manager and Clerk of this Municipality are hereby empowered to sign and execute the Agreement with the aforementioned groups.
