Public Art - Community Capacity Building

- <u>Public Art 101</u>: a workshop for local artists who wish to know more about what is required to successfully create public art, how to enter the field, and how creating work for communities differs from studio practice.
- <u>Regional Artist Directory</u>: provides contact information for artists who can create functional features for architecture – railings, decorative glass, mosaics, and murals. This directory will be a resource for citizens, municipal collaborators, and developers.
- <u>Neighborhood Matching Grant Program Public Art Fund</u>: \$30,000 of pooled public art funds allocated for neighborhoods to commission artwork.


