


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

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## **Community Investment Plan**

FY 2018-2022 Community Investment Plan continues the Council-approved **\$884.5 million** capital program occurring over four bond cycles (2014 – 2020), including:

- \$249.5 million approved in 2014  $\checkmark$
- \$295.4 million approved in 2016  $\checkmark$
- \$219.8 million programmed in 2018
- \$119.9 million programmed in 2020







## **Community Benefits**

- Livable Communities: Enhancing great places by addressing housing diversity, public safety, neighborhood improvements and quality of life needs
- Transportation Choices: Improving our transportation network, access to transit and overall connectivity by investing in streets, transit and pedestrian and bicycle facilities
- Job Growth: Promoting economic development and job creation by leveraging public-private partnerships and providing better access to major employment and retail areas
