## Petition 2017-204 by Ed Zepsa

## To Approve:

This petition is found to be inconsistent with the *Woodlawn Transit Station Area Plan* based on the information from the staff analysis and the public hearing, and because:

• The plan recommends low to moderate intensity office, industrial and warehouse-distribution uses.

(<u>However, we find</u>) this petition to be reasonable and in the public interest, based on the information from the staff analysis and the public hearing, and because:

- The adopted plan did not identify this site for the uses or urban form allowed by the MUDD (mixed use development district).
- At the time the plan was written, this area was not expected to transform into a
  more urban environment, but in recent years existing structures northwest of the
  area have converted from industrial/warehouse uses to mixed use structures. One
  notable example is the Olde Mecklenburg Brewery which includes a large eating and
  entertainment component; and
- The proposal will allow a building previously used for warehouse and distribution to be used for a range of non-industrial uses such as retail, eating/drinking/entertainment, office and residential uses; and
- The proposed development improves the site frontage with an eight-foot planting strip and eight-foot sidewalk which will improve both safety and the pedestrian experience.

## To Deny:

This petition is found to be inconsistent with the *Woodlawn Transit Station Area Plan* based on the information from the staff analysis and the public hearing, and because:
