





Charge from Mayor:

- ✓ "Review the Attorney's memo"
- ✓ "Assess the consequences of the implementation of four-years terms, including prior review of prior recommendations on the composition of Mayor and Council terms and any other applicable research"
- ✓ "Provide a recommendation for consideration by the full Council on the length and cycle for Mayor and Council terms and election cycle"

Committee Recommendations



- 1. Committee recommends that the Mayor and City Council transition from two-year terms to four-year terms. (Vote 3:2)
- 2. Committee recommends decision to transition from twoyear to four-year terms will be subject to a referendum. (Vote 4:1).
- 3. *Committee recommends the referendum should occur in line with a potential September election. (Vote 5-0)
- 4. Committee recommends staggered terms. (Vote 5-0)

^{*}City Attorney Bob Hagemann later advised that the law has changed recently which would require such a referendum, in an odd numbered election year, must be held during a November general election
