RESOLUTION CERTIFYING AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL BOND REFERENDUM ON THE BOND ORDERS AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$118,080,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION TRANSPORTATION BONDS, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$50,000,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION HOUSING BONDS AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$55,000,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENTS BONDS HELD FOR THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE, NORTH CAROLINA ON NOVEMBER 6, 2018

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina has considered the Certificate of Canvass of the Mecklenburg County Board of Elections canvassing the referendum held for the City of Charlotte, North Carolina on November 6, 2018 and certifying the result thereof to the City Council and has canvassed the result of said Referendum.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE, NORTH CAROLINA that it be and hereby is certified and declared that the number of voters registered and qualified to vote at said Referendum was 579,884.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it be and hereby is certified and declared that the total number of voters who voted "Yes" in answer to the question

"SHALL the order authorizing \$118,080,000 of bonds plus interest to provide funds to pay the capital costs of constructing, reconstructing, enlarging, extending and improving certain streets, including streets and roads constituting a part of the State highway system or otherwise the responsibility of the State and including the cost of related studies, streetscape and pedestrian improvements, relocation of utilities, plans and design; acquiring, constructing, reconstructing, widening, extending, paving, resurfacing, grading or improving streets, roads, intersections, parking lots and pedestrian and bicycle paths;

acquiring, constructing, reconstructing or improving sidewalks, curbs, gutters, drains, bridges, overpasses, underpasses and grade crossings and providing related landscaping, lighting and traffic controls, signals and markers; and the acquisition of land and rights-of-way in land required therefor, and providing that additional taxes may be levied in an amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds be approved?";

was <u>190,969</u>. The total number of voters who voted "No" in answer to such question was <u>85,955</u>. The question in the form submitted was APPROVED by the affirmative vote of a majority of those who voted thereon at said referendum.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it be and hereby is certified and declared that the total number of voters who voted "Yes" in answer to the question

"SHALL the order authorizing \$50,000,000 of bonds plus interest to pay the capital costs of housing projects for the benefit of persons of low income, or moderate income, or low and moderate income, including construction of infrastructure improvements related thereto and the acquisition of land and rights-of-way required therefor, and providing that additional taxes may be levied in an amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds be approved?";

was <u>190,275</u>. The total number of voters who voted "No" in answer to such question was <u>87,988</u>. The question in the form submitted was APPROVED by the affirmative vote of a majority of those who voted thereon at said referendum.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it be and hereby is certified and declared that the total number of voters who voted "Yes" in answer to the question

"SHALL the order authorizing \$55,000,000 of bonds plus interest to provide funds to pay the capital costs of infrastructure improvements for various neighborhoods of the City, including the cost of related studies, plans and design, acquiring, constructing, reconstructing, improving, installing or providing curbs, gutters, storm drainage, sidewalks, pedestrian and bicycle paths; paving, resurfacing, grading or improving streets, roads and intersections, providing public open space, landscaping and lighting, and acquiring any necessary equipment, land, interests in land and rights-of-way therefor, and providing that additional taxes may be levied in an amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds be approved?";

was <u>202,537</u>. The total number of voters who voted "No" in answer to such question was <u>75,653</u>. The question in the form submitted was APPROVED by the affirmative vote of a majority of those who voted thereon at said referendum.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a statement substantially in the form hereinafter set forth declaring the result of said referendum will be filed in the City Clerk's office and inserted in the City Council minutes and published in accordance with law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its adoption.
