Rule 5 of the Rules of Procedure for the Charlotte City Council is hereby amended as follows:

## 5. Addressing Council

. . .

(f) Scheduling Citizen Public Forum. A Citizens Public Forum shall be held at least once a month during which persons may speak on matters not on the agenda. To enable all citizens an equal opportunity to speak, a citizen may only speak at the Citizens Public Forum once each quarter. The number of speakers at a Citizen Public Forum shall be limited to ten (10) fifteen (15) unless otherwise agreed to by a majority of Council. If up to ten (10) persons have signed up to speak, each person shall be allowed to speak for up to three (3) minutes. If eleven (11) or more persons have signed up to speak, each person shall be allowed to speak for up to two (2) minutes but no more than fifteen (15) persons may speak during the Public Forum.
