## RESOLUTION PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE, NORTH CAROLINA ON DECEMBER $9^{th}$ , 2019

A motion was	made by and seconded by for
the adoption	of the following Resolution, and upon being put to a vote was duly adopted:
WHEREAS,	In 1995, Charlotte City Council approved a Water and Sewer Agreement between the Cit of Charlotte and the Water and Sewer Authority of Cabarrus County (WSACC), under which the City of Charlotte would construct certain sewer lines along Rocky River is northeast Mecklenburg County, and whereby WSACC would accept and treat wastewated discharged into those lines from Charlotte Water's wastewater collection system (the "Water and Sewer Agreement"); and
WHEREAS,	In 1997, 1998, and 1999, the City of Charlotte and WSACC modified the Water and Sewer Agreement to provide for construction of additional sewer lines along a tributary of Rock River known as Clarke Creek, which would serve other basins within eastern Mecklenbur County ("Phase I Amendment 1," "Phase II and III Amendment 2," and "Phase III Amendment 3"); and
WHEREAS,	In 2004, the City of Charlotte and WSACC modified the Water and Sewer Agreement to provide for construction of additional sewer lines along Reedy Creek, McKee Creek, and Caldwell Creek, whereby WSACC would accept and treat wastewater discharged into those lines from both eastern Mecklenburg County and Cabarrus County, and whereby WSACC would accept and treat wastewater discharged into those lines from Charlott Water's wastewater collection system ("Amendment 4"); and
WHEREAS,	In 2005, City of Charlotte and WSACC modified the Water and Sewer Agreement to provide for construction of additional sewer lines in both Mecklenburg and Cabarra Counties to serve the Fuda Creek Basin in eastern Mecklenburg County ("Amendment 5" and
WHEREAS,	The City of Charlotte and WSACC now seek to modify the Water and Sewer Agreement to partially fund a project originating in Cabarrus County and extending into Mecklenbur County in order to bypass wastewater flow from the Back Creek Pumping Station near University City Boulevard.
NOW THERE	FORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE:
	That the Modification to the Water and Sewer Agreement between the City of Charlott and the Water and Sewer Authority of Cabarrus County is hereby approved and ratified and the Director of Charlotte Water and any successor so titled, or his designees, is authorized to execute same.
