WHEREAS, the Charlotte Reg	gional Transportation Planning Organization (CRTPO) allocated State
Surface Transportation Block	Grant – Direct Attributable (STBG-DA) funding for transportation

improvements on the Idlewild/Rama/Monroe Road Intersection project (the "Project"),

WHEREAS, the Project will be fully funded using North Carolina Department of Transportation STBG-DA funds, beginning in the federal fiscal year 2020,

WHEREAS, a Municipal Agreement between the City and the State provides \$4,240,000 in state funding to the Project,

WHEREAS, the Municipal Agreement specifies items eligible for funding such as design, environmental documentation, right of way acquisition, utility relocation and construction costs, and

WHEREAS, the format and cost-sharing philosophy is consistent with past municipal agreements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a Municipal Agreement with the North Carolina Department of Transportation for the City to receive \$4,240,000 for transportation improvements on the Idlewild/Rama/Monroe Road Intersection project is hereby formally adopted by City Council of the City of Charlotte, and the City Manager and Clerk of this Municipality are hereby empowered to sign and execute the Agreement with the aforementioned groups.
