Butler House 240 Sylvania Avenue, Charlotte



The Butler House is representative of the history of the Lockwood neighborhood, originally developed as Locke Wood in 1915. The neighborhood was impacted by redlining policies that slowly shifted its demographics from a majority-white to a majority-black neighborhood following Urban Renewal in the 1960s and 1970s. The Butler House is an important artifact, as one of the best and most substantial examples of the Craftsman bungalow in Lockwood.
