


### **Current collection**


- Rearloader collection vehicle

- No limits to volume


### Challenges:

- Large scale yard waste piles
- Dangerous insects and animals
- Long work days
- Low employee morale

## **Proposed changes**

#### • Volume:

 Limitations on compostable bags and plastic bags

#### Preparation:

- Limbs < 4 feet in length and 18 inches in diameter
- Logs < 50 pounds
- Piles no higher or wider than a refrigerator on its back
- Scheduling of large scale piles:
  - Via 311
  - Boom truck collection vehicle
