Interrupt Violence

- Identified Jump Start funds for this effort
- Exploring key partnerships to stand up each of these two evidenced-based programs:

1) Hospital-Based Violence Intervention

Engaging violence victims in the hospital, during their recovery to receive assessment, counseling and social support in order to reduce recidivism

2) Street Outreach Violence Interruption

Outreach workers focus on people at highest risk of becoming involved with or victims of violence, and connect individuals with direct support services like conflict mediation, case management, mentoring etc.

- Upward Mobility Fellowship provides funding and resources to community-based organizers to address economic immobility and build infrastructure for organizing within their communities.
- Resource organizers living in neighborhoods experiencing economic immobility and heightened crime
