




### REMOVING BARRIERS TO PARTICIPATION

From FY2015 to FY2019 the city added 821 certified vendors







#### TOTAL MWSBE SPEND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019



In FY2019 the City of Charlotte's spend with MWSBEs totaled over \$133 million




### TOTAL MWSBE SPEND BY CERTIFICATION TYPE & WORK CATEGORY




From FY2018 to FY2019 the city's spend with MWSBEs increased by over \$31 million


