- Administration and Congress were negotiating a fifth coronavirus emergency relief measure, CARES 5
- CARES 5 talks are at an impasse and over the weekend, the President took unilateral action on eviction moratorium, unemployment benefits, deferral of payroll taxes and student loan payment relief
- Expecting an omnibus FY 2021 appropriations measure to be passed sometime after the election

- General Assembly convened short session on April 28 and adjourned on July 11
- Addressed policy issues resulting from the pandemic
- Enacted budget reductions due to revenue shortfalls resulting from the pandemic
- General Assembly reconvenes on September 2 to appropriate any federal funds received in response to the pandemic

- Requests from Council Members

- **August 25:** Intergovernmental Relations Committee will hold joint meeting with the Mecklenburg County Intergovernmental Relations Committee
- Focus on Mobility issues
- Mr. Jaiyeoba will be briefing the joint committee on the work of Charlotte Moves

- **September 21:** Intergovernmental Relations Committee will be considering requests from Committees, Council Members and staff
- **October 19:** Committee will propose state and federal legislative agendas for Council consideration
- Proposed legislative agendas will be before Council
 - **November 2:** Strategy Session
 - **November 16:** Action Review
 - **November 23:** Business Meeting for adoption

- **January 3:** US Congress convenes
 - Congressional Briefings are planned to coincide with the NLC Congressional Cities Conference scheduled for March 7 – 10
- **January 13:** 2021 General Assembly convenes
 - State Delegation Briefing planned for between December 7 – 18
