A Resolution to Call for a Public Hearing to Consider Designating the William H. Peeps House (831 East Worthington Avenue) as a Local Historic Landmark



The William H. Peeps House, built 1918-1919, is historically significant for its association with prominent architect William H. Peeps, who designed many landmark buildings in Charlotte and the surrounding region. In addition, it is architecturally significant as the only surviving house known to be designed and occupied by the architect (1919-1950), and continuously occupied by his family thereafter until 1990.
