Thank you for submitting the report for the amendment to the **Victor Shaw House, 2400 Mecklenburg Ave., Charlotte, Mecklenburg County.** We have reviewed the information in the report and offer the following comments in accordance with North Carolina General Statute 160D-946 (formerly 160A-400.6).

According to the report, the Shaw House is of local historical importance for its association with Victor Shaw, who was a particularly influential mayor of Charlotte during a period of exceptional growth in the city.

We have shared recommendations with staff to perform changes to the report. With this change, the designation report should provide the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Historic Landmark Commission and the local governing board determine whether the new boundary for the Victor Shaw House provides a sufficient setting for the house to communicate its historic association with Mayor Shaw.

Landmark designation means the community recognizes properties within the historic district are worthy of preservation because of their special significance to the local community. Any substantial changes in design, materials, and appearance to these properties is subject to the design review procedures of the preservation commission.

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the report. Please note, our comments are advisory only and therefore, non-binding. Once the governing board has received a recommendation from the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Historic Landmarks Commission, it should proceed in the same manner as would otherwise be required for an amendment to the zoning ordinance.
