### Phase 2

- October 13 November 14, 2021
- 1st Draft Charlotte Future 2040 Policy Map (Online & Hardcopies)
  - Citywide Informational Meeting (605 Views)
  - 33 Community Conversations (To Date: **193 participants**) + Drop-In Office Hours
  - Online Comment Application (To Date: 261 comments)


#### Phase 3

- Consider criteria to upgrade Commercial to Neighborhood Activity Centers to better align with 10-Minute Neighborhood Goal
- Evaluate evolution of Neighborhood 1 along major corridors to Neighborhood 2
