The City receives the Byrne Justice Assistance Grant on an annual basis. Like several other annual grants in Police, Fire, CDOT, and CRC the grant is appropriated in the General Grants Fund as part of the Budget Process.</p>
CM Winston	44. 15-16299 Construct North Tryon Street and 36th Street Streetscape Project <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How are we controlling for perceived supply chain & labor disruptions when accounting for CBI good faith efforts? 	<p>City Council's GFE policy is designed to capture evidence of the effort that a prime contractor puts forth when the goal cannot be met.</p> <p>With respect to Item #44, Sealand Contractors satisfied the GFE requirement as it relates to the SBE goal. The City does not specifically require a prime to report the reason for a subcontractor's lack of interest. In this case, the prime contacted 151 certified SBEs the majority of which were listed as non-responsive.</p> <p>City procurement and construction staff are monitoring impacts of supply chain and labor shortage issues. Thus far issues are isolated to delays due to longer than usual lead times for some materials. Staff has been managing the issues on a project-by-project basis.</p>
