Reflective Roadway and Runway Marking Material

Action:

- A. Approve a unit price contract with Potters Industries, LLC for the purchase of reflective glass beads for a term of three years, and
- B. Authorize the City Manager to renew the contract for up to two, one-year terms with possible price adjustments and to amend the contract consistent with the purpose for which the contract was approved.

Explanation

- The city uses reflective glass beads to mark roadways and runways for higher visibility.
- On April 1, 2024, the city issued an Invitation to Bid; one bid was received.
- Potters Industries, LLC was selected as the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.
- The contract prices shall remain fixed for the initial three-year term. At renewal, price adjustments
 may be considered based on legitimate and justified increases in the cost of doing business. The
 ability to consider price adjustments also allows the city to accept decreases, if warranted.
- Annual expenditures are estimated to be \$155,000.
