**Explanation**

- North Carolina General Statute 160A-299 outlines the procedures for permanently closing streets and alleys.
- The Charlotte Department of Transportation received a petition to abandon public right-of-way and requests this City Council action in accordance with the statute.
- The action removes land from public right-of-way status and attaches it to the adjacent property.
- This abandonment aligns with approved rezoning petition 2017-203.
- The alleyway off of West Worthington Avenue is located in Council District 3.
