## Electronic Auction for Disposal of Surplus Dewatering Centrifuges

### Action:

- A. Adopt a resolution declaring specific equipment as surplus,**

- C. Authorize the City Manager to approve certain administrative and storage fees as may be required from time to time for auction events.**

### **Explanation**

- Pursuant to North Carolina General Statute 160A-270(c), approval is requested for an electronic auction.
- Charlotte Water is requesting the disposal of two Alfa Laval Sharples DC-906 Centrifuges.
- The electronic auction will be conducted by Rogers Realty and Auction Company ([www.rogersauctiongroup.com](http://www.rogersauctiongroup.com)). On January 11, 2016, Council approved a contract with Rogers Realty and Auction Company, Inc. for auctioneer and related services as the result of a competitive selection process.
- The auction company will be compensated through auction proceeds (seven percent of the total gross sales price).
- Net proceeds from this auction will be distributed to Charlotte Water.
