Traffic Signal Equipment

Action:

- A. Award a unit price contract to the lowest responsive bidder Halifax Security, Inc. dba North American Video for the purchase of traffic signal related equipment for a threeyear term, and
- B. Authorize the City Manager to renew the contract for up to two, one-year terms with possible price adjustments and to amend the contract consistent with the purpose for which the contract was approved.

Cooperative Purchasing Exemption

N.C. S.L. 2001-328, effective January 1, 2002, authorizes competitive group purchasing.

Explanation

- The Charlotte Department of Transportation installs and maintains traffic signal equipment, including cameras and cables. This equipment requires continuous maintenance and replacement.
- On October 10, 2018, the City issued an Invitation to Bid; five bids were received.
- Halifax Security, Inc. dba North American Video was selected as the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.
- Annual expenditures are estimated to be \$130,000.
