Solids Hauling Services for Wastewater Package Plants

Action:

- A. Approve a unit price contract with L & L Environmental Services LLC for Solids Hauling Services for Wastewater Package Plants for an initial term of one year, and**
- B. Authorize the City Manager to renew the contract for up to four, one-year terms with possible price adjustments and to amend the contract consistent with the purpose for which the contract was approved.**

Explanation

- The City requires solids hauling services for two wastewater package plants operated by Charlotte Water in the Town of Mint Hill. Package wastewater plants are utilized to provide on-site wastewater treatment for a subdivision when the public system is too far from the development.
- These package plants require solids hauling services to transfer non-hazardous waste materials to the McAlpine Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant, located in the Town of Pineville (adjacent to Council District 7), for proper disposal.
- On October 9, 2018, the City issued a Request for Proposals (RFP); four proposals were received.
- L & L Environmental Services LLC, a state permitted company, is the best qualified firm to meet the City's needs on the basis of demonstrated competence and qualification of professional services in response to the RFP requirements.
- Annual expenditures are estimated to be \$150,000.
