# Resolution of Intent to Abandon Two Unopened Alleyways Off of Karendale Avenue

#### **Action:**

A. Adopt a Resolution of Intent to abandon two unopened alleyways off of Karendale Avenue, and

B. Set a Public Hearing for May 13, 2019.

#### **Explanation**

- North Carolina General Statute 160A-299 outlines the procedures for permanently closing streets and alleys.
- The Charlotte Department of Transportation received a petition to abandon public right-of-way and requests this City Council action in accordance with the statute.
- The action removes land from public right-of-way status and attaches it to the adjacent property.
- The two alleyways are off of Karendale Avenue and are located in Council District 3.
