## **Bypass Pumping Services**

#### Action:

- Approve unit price contracts with the following companies for bypass pumping services Α. for an initial term of three years:
  - Western Oilfields Supply Company,

- \_ **Xylem Dewatering Solutions, and** 
  - Sunbelt Rentals Inc., and
- Β. Authorize the City Manager to renew the contracts for up to two, two-year terms with possible price adjustments and to amend the contracts consistent with the purpose for which the contracts were approved.

#### Explanation

- This action authorizes contracts to rent pumps and related equipment with multiple vendors to perform bypass pumping throughout the entire water and wastewater system.
- Bypass pumping is used to temporarily reroute flow during scheduled or emergency repairs.
- A contract award to multiple vendors will ensure access to resources for these emergency services.
- On February 26, 2019, the city issued a Request for Proposals (RFP); three responses were . received.
- The companies selected meet the city's needs in terms of qualifications, experience, cost, and • responsiveness to RFP requirements.
- Annual expenditures for all contracts combined are estimated to be \$1,800,000.
