Citywide Wash Products and Services for Trucks, Equipment, and Rail Cars

Action:

- A. Approve a unit price contract to the lowest responsive bidder Loyal Systems, Inc. for the purchase of truck and train wash products and services for an initial term of three years, and
- B. Authorize the City Manager to renew the contract for up to two, one-year terms with possible price adjustments and to amend the contract consistent with the purpose for which the contract was approved.

Explanation

- The city purchases chemicals, repair parts, and services for drive-through wash facilities owned by the city.
- These chemicals and services are used to wash, maintain, and disinfect various heavy trucks and equipment, including, but not limited to, Solid Waste Services collection trucks; dump trucks, sewer trucks, and rodder trucks operated by Charlotte Water; salt spreaders and road repair equipment operated by the Charlotte Department of Transportation; and rail cars operated by the Charlotte Area Transit System.
- On August 9, 2019, the city issued an Invitation to Bid; three bids were received.
- Loyal Systems, Inc. was selected as the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.
- Total annual expenditures are estimated to be \$200,000.

Charlotte Business INClusion
