## Resolution of Intent to Abandon an Alleyway off Morningside Drive

### Action:

- A. Adopt a resolution of intent to abandon an alleyway off Morningside Drive, and**
- B. Set a public hearing for October 11, 2021.**

### **Explanation**

- North Carolina General Statute 160A-299 outlines the procedures for permanently closing streets and alleys.
- The Charlotte Department of Transportation received a petition to abandon public right-of-way and requests this City Council action in accordance with the statute.
- The action removes land from public right-of-way status and attaches it to the adjacent property.
- The alley is located in Council District 1.
