## Resolution of Intent to Abandon an Unopened Right-of-Way off Rocky River Road Parallel to Rockland Drive

### Explanation

- North Carolina General Statute Section 160A-299 outlines the procedures for permanently closing streets and alleys.
- The Charlotte Department of Transportation received a petition to abandon public right-of-way and requests this City Council action in accordance with the statute.
- The action removes land from public right-of-way status and attaches it to the adjacent property.
- The right-of-way is located in Council District 4.
