## Support a North Carolina Department of Transportation Safety Project

### Action:

**Adopt a resolution supporting a North Carolina Department of Transportation safety project on NC 24/27 (Albemarle Road) at Reddman Road to improve traffic safety in support of the Vision Zero Action Plan.**

### **Explanation**

- The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) conducted an evaluation of crash history at the intersection of Albemarle Road and Reddman Road.
- The evaluation revealed a history of angle crashes for vehicles exiting a driveway immediately west of Reddman Road.
- NCDOT proposed the installation of a concrete median on Albemarle Road west of Reddman Road to restrict left turns to and from the driveway entrance.
- NCDOT will fully fund the cost of these improvements.
- The project requires a resolution of support for the use of NCDOT High Hazard Elimination funding.
- The project supports the Vision Zero Action Plan by advancing a safe transportation system for all users.
- NCDOT anticipates beginning design in Fiscal Year 2022.
- This intersection is in Council District 5.
