Water and Sanitary Sewer Service Installations

Action:

Approve a contract in the amount of \$5,293,489.30 to the lowest responsive bidder, Fuller & Co. Construction, LLC (SBE) for water and sanitary sewer service installations.

Explanation

- This contract is for small diameter water and sanitary sewer service installations and service dismantlement.
- On November 4, 2021, the City issued an Invitation to Bid (ITB); two bids were received.
 - NC General Statute Section 143-132 prohibits municipalities from awarding construction contracts over \$500,000 without receiving at least three competitive bids from the initial advertisement of the contract. The City may subsequently award the contract even if readvertisements result in fewer than three competitive bids.
- On November 30, 2021, the ITB was re-issued; two bids were received.
- Fuller & Co. Construction, LLC was selected as the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.

Charlotte Business INClusion

Fuller & Co. Construction, LLC is a City-certified SBE.

Per Charlotte Business INClusion Policy: Part C: Section 2.1(a) The City shall not establish subcontracting goals for contracts where: (a) there are not subcontracting opportunities identified for the contract; or (b) there are no SBEs or MBEs certified to perform the scopes of work that the City regards as realistic opportunities for subcontracting.

This contract meets the provisions of (a) - No subcontracting opportunities.
