# Public Hearing on a Resolution to Close an Unopened Portion of Whittington Street

A. Conduct a public hearing to close an Unopened Portion of Whittington Street, and

#### **Explanation**

- NC General Statute Section 160A-299 outlines the procedures for permanently closing streets and alleys.
- The Charlotte Department of Transportation (CDOT) received a petition to abandon public right-ofway and requests this City Council action in accordance with the statute.
- The action removes land from public right-of-way and attaches it to the adjacent property.
- The attached Resolution refers to exhibits and metes and bounds descriptions that are available in the City Clerk's Office.
- The right-of-way to be closed is located in Council District 4.

#### Right-of-Way to be Abandoned
