## Consideration of Changes to Form of Government

### Explanation

- Recommendations from the 2020 Citizen Advisory Committee of Governance (CACG) that remain pending include:
  - Moving from Two-Year terms to Four-Year terms,
  - Implementing Staggered Elections, and
  - Redistricting to add an 8th District, keeping 11 Representatives but move from four At-Large Representatives to three At-Large Representatives to add 8<sup>th</sup> District Representative.
