American Airlines Storeroom Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning System

Action:

- A. Award a contract in the amount of \$152,467 to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder Colonial Webb Contractors Company for the purchase and installation of a HVAC system, and**
- B. Adopt a budget ordinance appropriating \$152,467 from the Aviation Discretionary Fund to the Aviation Community Investment Plan Fund.**

- This contract will provide for the purchase and installation of a new heating ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) system for American Airline's store room.
- On March 31, 2017, the City issued an Invitation to Bid for American Airlines Storeroom HVAC system, two bids were received from interested service providers.
- Colonial Webb Contractors Company was selected as the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.
