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### **Runway 18R/36L Safety Area Grading Improvements**

#### **Action:**

**Award a contract in the amount of \$1,017,825 to the lowest responsive bidder Hi-Way Paving, Inc. for the Runway 18R/36L Safety Area Grading Improvement project.**

#### **Explanation**

- This project consists of grading, erosion control, and grass seeding of the Runway Safety Areas (RSA) for Runway 18R-36L in order to meet Federal Aviation Administration requirements.
- On May 22, 2017, the City issued an Invitation to Bid; three bids were received from interested service providers.
- Hi-Way Paving, Inc. was selected as the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.
- The project is anticipated to be complete by the end of calendar year 2017.
