### Resolution of Intent to Abandon a Portion of Township Road

#### **Action:**

- A. Adopt a Resolution of Intent to abandon a portion of Township Road, and**
- B. Set a public hearing date for February 12, 2018.**

#### **Policy**

- To abandon right-of-way that is no longer needed for public use

#### **Explanation**

- North Carolina General Statute 160A-299 outlines the procedures for permanently closing streets and alleys.
- The Charlotte Department of Transportation received a petition to abandon public right-of-way and requests this Council action in accordance with the statute.
- The action removes land from public right-of-way status and attaches it to the adjacent property.
- The attached resolution refers to exhibits and metes and bounds descriptions that are available in the City Clerk's Office.
- The portion of Township Road is located in Council District 3.
