In Rem Remedy: 2605 Booker Avenue

For In Rem Remedy, the public purpose and policy are outlined here.

Public Purpose:

- Eliminate a blighting influence;
- Reduce the proportion of substandard housing;
- Increase tax value of property by making land available for potential infill housing development;
 and
- Support public safety initiatives.

Policy:

Housing & Neighborhood Development and Community Safety

The In Rem Remedy items were initiated from 3 categories:

- 1. Public Safety Police and/or Fire Departments
- 2. Complaint petition by citizens, tenant complaint, or public agency referral
- 3. Field Observation concentrated code enforcement program

The In Rem Remedy item is listed below by category identifying the street address and neighborhood.

Field Observation: (2605 Booker Avenue, Council District 2)

Action:

Adopt an Ordinance authorizing the use of In Rem Remedy to demolish and remove the structure at (2605 Booker Avenue) (Neighborhood Profile Area 85).
